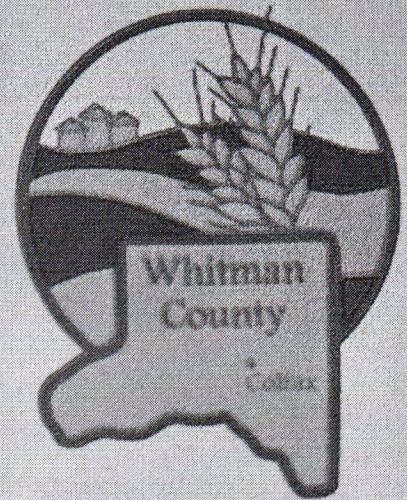

"Shall the Rosalia Park & Recreation District No. 5 be authorized to impose a special (excess) tax levy of \$.53 cents per thousand dollars of assessed valuation, to be collected in the year 2026 in order to collect \$93,000.00 for the Rosalia Park and Swimming Pool, to help defray the costs of operation and maintenance?"

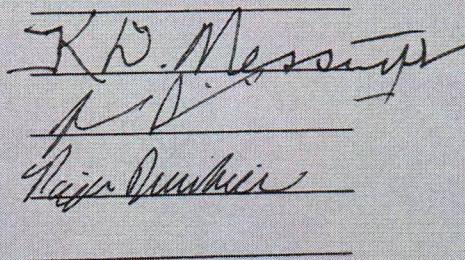

Explanatory statement

This levy is created by Rosalia park and rec in order to continue operating the pool for 2025 and to continue offering activities for the children and patrons of the community. Without this Levy we will be unable to obtain funding to operate the pool and park facilities in 2025.

We are asking for more funding as costs have went up and the current amount we have been asking for prior is not enough to keep employees and pay for the cost to maintain and run the pool

Rosalia Pool with the help of the Whitman County Health Department was able to provide over 50 children with swimming lessons. Even with the help the pool still had to cover the expenses of the wages to have the guards provide swimming lessons.

Rosalia park and rec has been able to continue doing night swims game days and prizes for the children at the pool. They have also been able to buy some new sports equipment for kids to check out at the office.

We would like to continue to help and support the park. More funding will make it, so the park is available to provide updates to the park pool and basketball court.
